Official Publication ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY NOXIOUS WEEDS & ENCROACHMENT

Rural Redwood County residents are reminded that the Redwood County road rights-of-way spray crew will be spraying from May through October. If you **DO NOT** want your rights-of-way sprayed (due to ditch hay harvesting), please post a sign at the beginning of the property (stop spray) and at the end (start spray). The signs should be in place prior to May 1, 2022 and can be removed after November 1, 2022. Note: Landowners are responsible for control of noxious weeds in the rights-of-way if they choose to post the signs.

The Redwood County Highway Dept. would like to remind landowners about right-of-way encroachment along County roads. Anyone disturbing the County's right-of-way markers or anyone disturbing the County's right-of-way by tilling or spraying a herbicide that kills the right-of-way vegetation will be subject to misdemeanor prosecution pursuant to statute 160.2715. In addition, the landowner will be required to seed these areas as needed.
