## **REDWOOD COUNTY POLICY**

- 1. A written application for a driveway permit shall be processed through the County Engineer's office for each new, widened or moved driveway.
- 2. All work is subject to the approval of the County Engineer.
- 3. The applicant shall be responsible for the labor, equipment and materials needed to construct the driveway. All costs related to the driveway construction will be the applicant's expense. A \$500 deposit will be required before approval of the application. The deposit will be returned to the applicant upon final inspection and approval by the Highway Department.
- 4. All gravel base removed must be replaced and thoroughly recompacted, with a final thickness equal to original, or greater.
- 5. All bituminous surfacing removed must be squared off, tack applied to all joints, and replaced with equal, or greater thickness of Mn/DOT bituminous mixture, type specified by the County Engineer.
- 6. Curb and gutter removal and replacement is to be per the sketch below. Dowel all new-old joints.
