Funeral and Burial Expenses

- Family members*
- A friend/acquaintance that has paid funeral expenses
- Funeral services and burial
- Headstone/marker
- Obituary, hall rental, flowers, clergy, thank-you notes, etc.
- Transportation and lodging for family members to attend funeral (\$1,000 max)

Maximum payment: \$7,500 plus \$1,000 for headstone/marker

Lost Wages

- Victim
- •Family members* of victim

Maximum for victim:

•52 weeks

Maximum for parents, and spouse/domestic partner (Cases involving a death):

•52 weeks

Maximum for siblings, children, and grandparents (Cases involving a death):

•6 weeks

Estimated Tax:

Maximum for family members* who provide care to an injured victim:

 Payment to all family members combined for lost wages, transportation and lodging cannot exceed \$5,000

Rules:

- Max of 40 hrs/wk
- Self employed/unemployed-wage loss based on previous year's tax return
- Time missed to attend court proceedings, or to meet with police, attorneys or probation officers is not covered

Mental Health Counseling

- Victim
- •Family members* of victim
- ·Witness to a crime
- Person who discovers body of the victim

•\$20,000 or less-15% •More than \$20,000-25%

- counselingDiagnostic and testing
- Cultural healing services up to \$1,500

Individual, family and group

Mileage to and from appointments

Not Covered:

- Court appearances/case reviews for court proceedings
- Reviewing test results
- Reunification or any session with perpertrator present

Loss of Support

- •Spouse/domestic partner
- Children under 18 years of age
- Maximum payment: \$7,500
 •\$400 per month for each
- dependent
 Paid annually

Needs Test: After 3 years, claims are reviewed by staff for ongoing eligibility based on household income

Miscellaneous Expenses

- Child care—victim unable to provide care due to injury or death
- •Home Health Care—injured victim requiring home health care
- Crime scene clean-up—victim or family member*
- Return of abducted child—parent or lawful custodian of kidnapped child

Childcare:

- ·Licensed-Standard rate
- •\$3/hr day, \$4/hr night
- •24 hour care-\$250/wk 1 child, \$350/wk 2 or more

Crime Scene Clean-up:

- Victim or family member billed for expense
- •\$10,000 maximum
- •Damage due to police investigation or evidence collection not covered

Return of Abducted Child:

- Transportation and lodging to return located victim
- ·Search costs not covered

Home Health Care:

- Performed by licensed provider
- Family and household members excluded
- * Family members—parents, spouse/domestic partner, siblings, children, and grandparents

All expenses must be reasonable and directly related to the crime for which the claim was filed.



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
