## **AUTHORIZATION OF PERMIT**

In consideration of (his)(their) agreement to comply in all respects with the regulations of the County Highway Department covering such operations, permission is hereby granted for the work to be done as described in the above application, said work to be done in accordance with special precautions required as hereby stated:

It is expressly understood that this permit is conditional upon replacement or restoration of the County Highway to its original or to a satisfactory condition. It is further understood that this permit is issued subject to the approval of local city, village or borough authorities having joint supervision over said street of highway.

This application form to be used for installation of service connections or extensions of existing underground utilities including crossing of County Highways or for placing temporary obstructions on the right-of-way.

## PERTINENT REGULATIONS

- 1. Flags, flares and barricades shall be erected to protect traffic and persons. (Par. 1707.)
- 2. Traffic to be allowed to pass and to be protected at all times. (Par. 1707, 1-1708.)
- 3. Barricades to be erected in a manner which will provide suitable visibility in all directions.
- 4. If blasting is necessary, precautions must be exercised. Par. 1709 Spec. Man. (Use of Explosives.)
- 5. If work to be done lies within a municipality or platted town, permission must be obtained from such village, town or city.
- 6. Excavations must be cribbed when necessary, depending upon type of soil, in order to prevent cave-ins.
- 7. No guys or stays to be attached to trees on County Highway Right-of-Way.
- 8. Underground construction must be so constructed as not to harm or unnecessarily destroy the root growth of sightly or ornamental trees.
- 9. Installation of pipe under concrete or high type of bituminous pavements to be done by jacking or boring.
- 10. When trenching across surfaced roads, material excavated must be piled separately.
- 11. All back-filling must be placed in 6" layers and thoroughly tamped and material must be flush and even with the road surface when finally in place.
- 12. If pavement or roadway is damaged, same shall be restored to original condition.
- 13. Concrete payement to be replaced according to State specifications.
- 14. If settlement occurs or excavation caves in so that replaced materials settle (bituminous mat or concrete base), same shall be restored to its original condition.
- 15. No pole anchors, anchors, braces or other construction to be put on roadway shoulder, except by permit authorization.
- 16. No driving onto highway from ditch or driving on shoulders where damage will occur.
- 17. When an installation is made by jacking or boring, a pipe or casing of larger dimension may be required to encase the service pipe. This requirement shall be at the discretion of the County Engineer.
- 18. No lugs shall be used on equipment traversing road which will damage the road surface.
- 19. Roadside should be cleaned up after work is complete. Par. 1411-Page 1409.
- 20. If Highway Department shall make any improvements or change on all or part of its R/W upon, over, under, or along the County Highway, then and in every case the applicant herein named shall after notice from the County Engineer or his authorized agents proceed to alter, change, vacate or remove from trunk highway R/W said works necessary to conform with said changes without cost whatsoever to the County of Redwood.
- 21. If drains are installed they must be sufficient size in order that overflow and damage to property will not occur.
- 22. No work shall be done which will create a nuisance.
- 23. After work on a project is completed, said persons doing such work must notify the Area Maintenance Supervisor.
