

Joint Drainage Authority Teleconference  
March 21, 2017  
8:15

Commissioner Potter convened the teleconference with Redwood County at 8:15 a.m. In attendance were: Commissioners Potter, Simonsen and Windschitl from Brown County, Commissioners Walling and Groebner from Redwood County. Others attending from Brown County: Jean Prochniak, Auditor-Treasurer, Wayne Stevens, Drainage Inspector, and Administrator Enter. From Redwood County: Vicky Knobloch, Administrator and Jean Price, Auditor-Treasurer. Viewer Mark Behrends was in attendance as well.

The first order of business was to approve the minutes of the March 7, 2017 public hearing held at the Springfield Community Center. Motion was made by Lon Walling, second by Scott Windschitl to accept the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Scott Windshitl to accept the Findings of Fact and Order for Bruce Moe to outlet 30 acres into JD 12B&R. It was reiterated that the petitioner was responsible for the \$1,500 outlet fee payable prior to commencement of tiling, that \$3,270 of benefits would be added to parcel 120.004.003.11.040 and that the petitioner will be billed for all expenses incurred with this petition process. Second by Dean Simonsen. Motion Carried.

It was noted that the ditch percentages were to be adjusted and that Brown County now has 96.79% of the benefits and Redwood County would have 3.21%.

Motion by Dean Simonsen, second by Lon Walling to adjourn. Motion Carried. Meeting was adjourned at 8:20 a.m.
