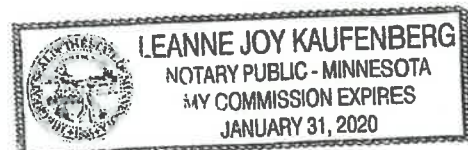

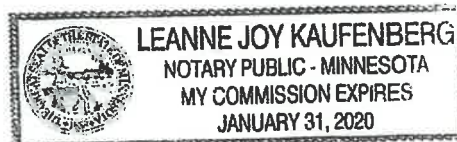

NOTICE OF FINAL HEARING

In the Matter of the Redetermination of Benefits of the following drainage systems described below in the County of Redwood, State of Minnesota.

WHEREAS, the Redwood County Drainage Authority has appointed viewers to redetermine the benefits and damages determined for each drainage system described below in the County of Redwood, State of Minnesota, and whereas, the Viewers Report for the Redetermination of Benefits for each drainage system has been filed with the Office of the Redwood County Auditor-Treasurer.

The drainage system affect properties in:

County Ditch 109: Sections 3-9, 15-22, 28, 29	T 111 N	R 34 W (Morgan Twp)
Sections 1, 11-14	T 111 N	R 35 W (Three Lakes Twp)
Sections 28-34	T 112 N	R 34 W (Sherman Twp)
Section 36	T 112 N	R 35 W (Paxton Twp)

County Ditch # 109 consists of approximately 9.8 miles of open ditch and 29.7 miles of drainage tile benefitting an area of 4293 acres. County Ditch #109 empties into an unnamed stream, which in turn empties into Wabasha Creek. It drains parts of seventeen sections of Morgan Township, five sections of Three Lakes Township, seven sections of Sherman Township, one section of Paxton Township, and part of the City of Morgan. The Open Ditch of County Ditch #109 begins in Section 13 of Morgan Township and the flow is northerly until it empties into an unnamed stream in Section 28 of Sherman Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that a final hearing on said Redeterminations be had before the Redwood County Drainage Authority on Tuesday, March 5th, 2019 starting at 10:30 am in the Commissioners Room of the Redwood County Government Center, 403 South Mill Street, Redwood Falls, Minnesota. Said authority will consider said Redeterminations, hear all parties of interest and take such action concerning each drainage system affected.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Notice of the Hearing be given to all parties in interest pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 103E.325.
