The Board of County Commissioners met for an emergency meeting at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room in the Government Center, Redwood Falls, Minnesota.

Present for all or portions of the meeting were Commissioners Dave Forkrud, Lon Walling, Bob Van Hee, Jim Salfer and Dennis Groebner; County Administrator Vicki Knobloch; Human Resource Coordinator Peter Brown; Recorder Joyce Anderson; Environmental Director Scott Wold; A/T Jean Price, County Engineer Al Forsberg; Sheriff Randy Hanson; Assessor Kathy Hillmer and Licensing Supervisor Lisa Guggisberg.

Chair Walling called the emergency meeting pursuant to Minn. Stat. 13D.04, subd. 3 for the sole and specific purpose of addressing Governor Walz's Emergency Executive Order 20-20.

- On motion by Forkrud, second by Van Hee, in a 4-1 vote with Walling voting nay, the Board authorized Department Heads the option to implement a rotating schedule in their department and place staff on paid administrative leave with full support of the County Board effective April 6th through April 21st, 2020.
- Further discussion will ensue at the April 21, 2020 board meeting as the Board will continue to re-evaluate the situation and discuss additional options including, but not limited to staff furlough and/or layoffs.
