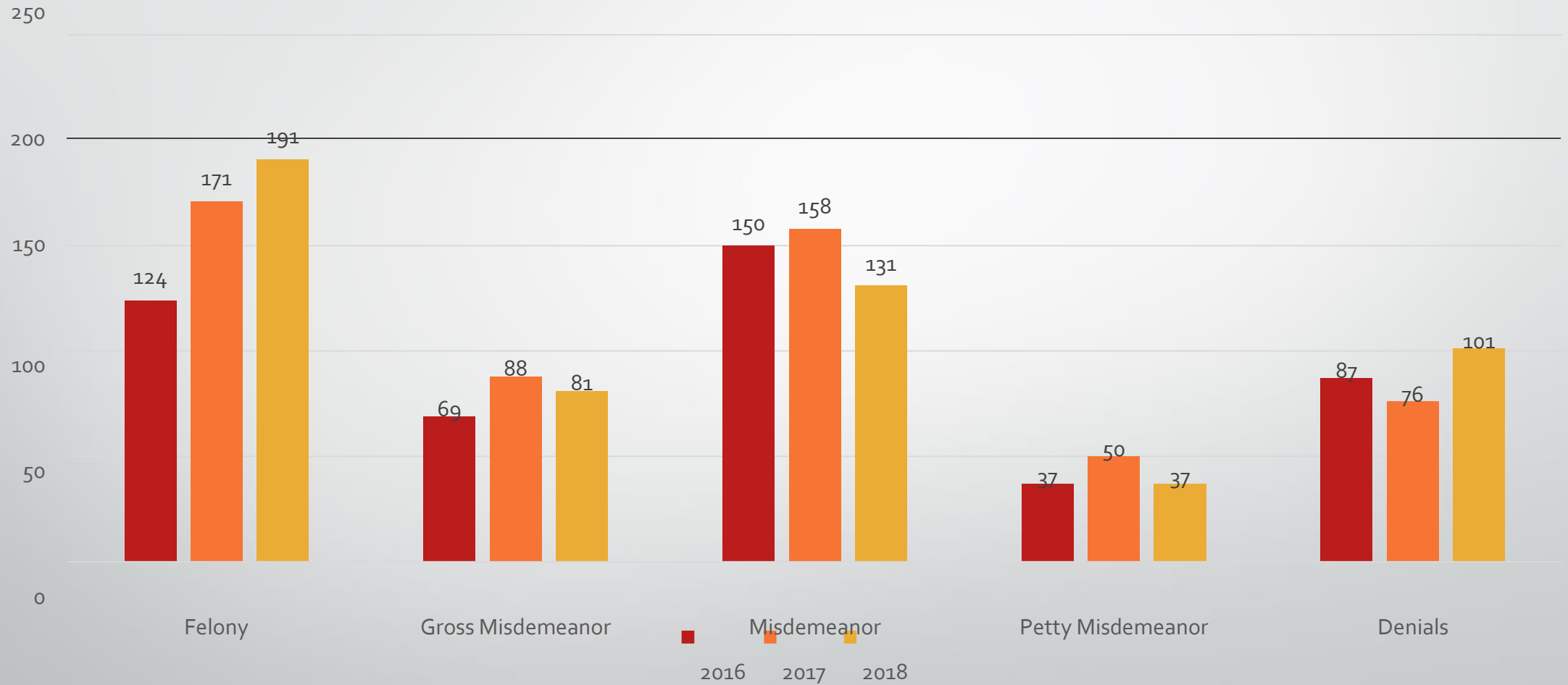
Adult Criminal Files

 - 2016 = 467



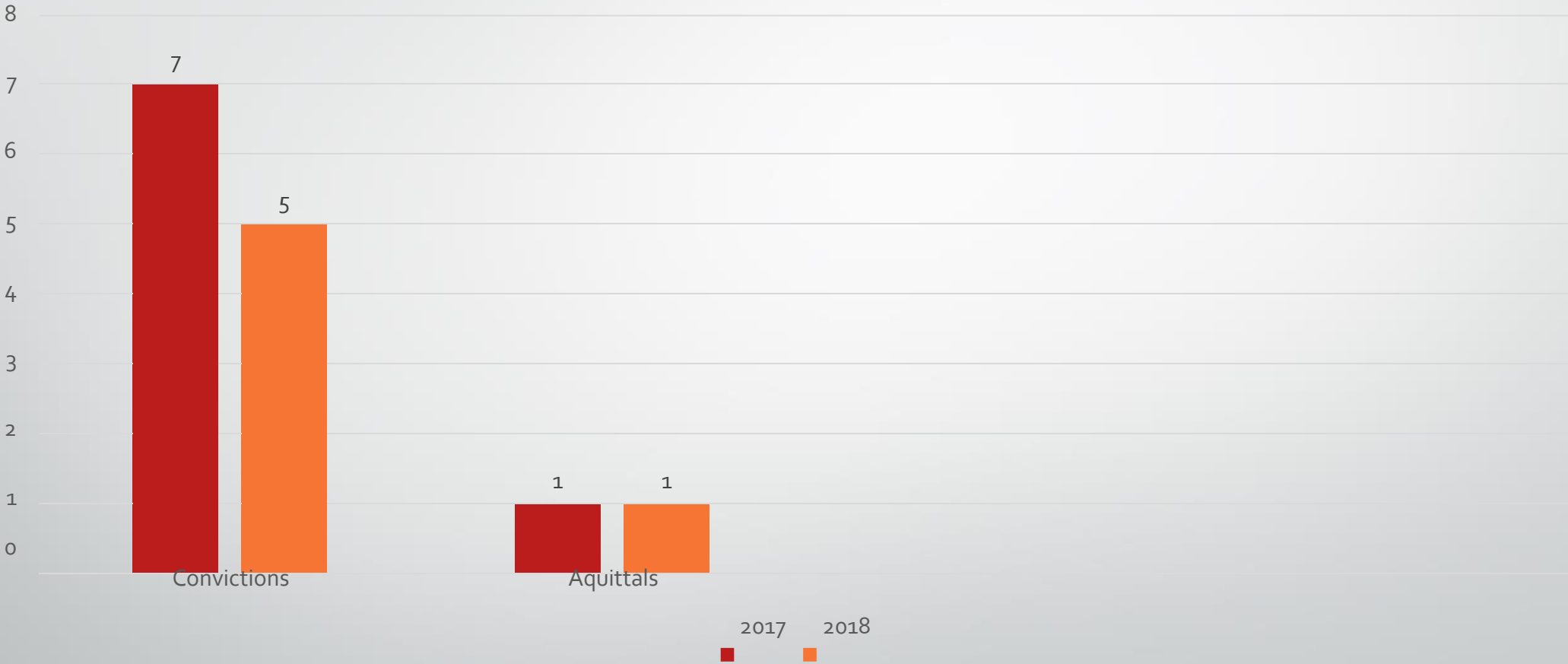

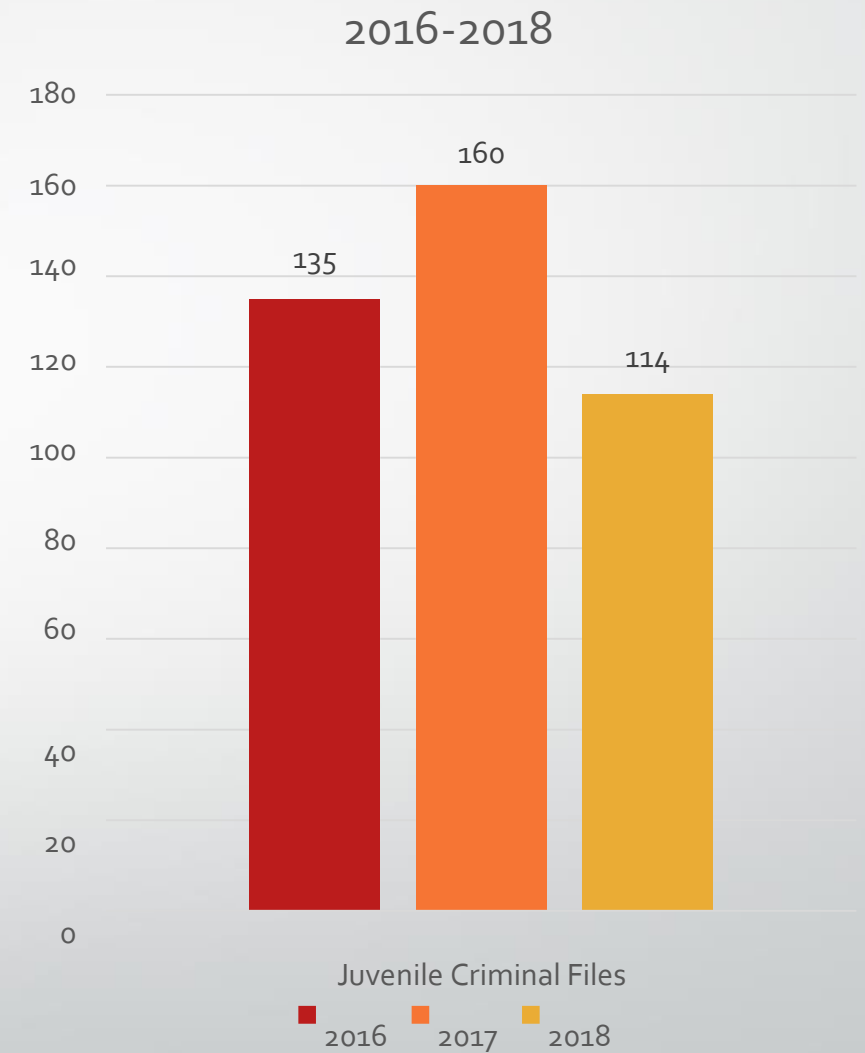

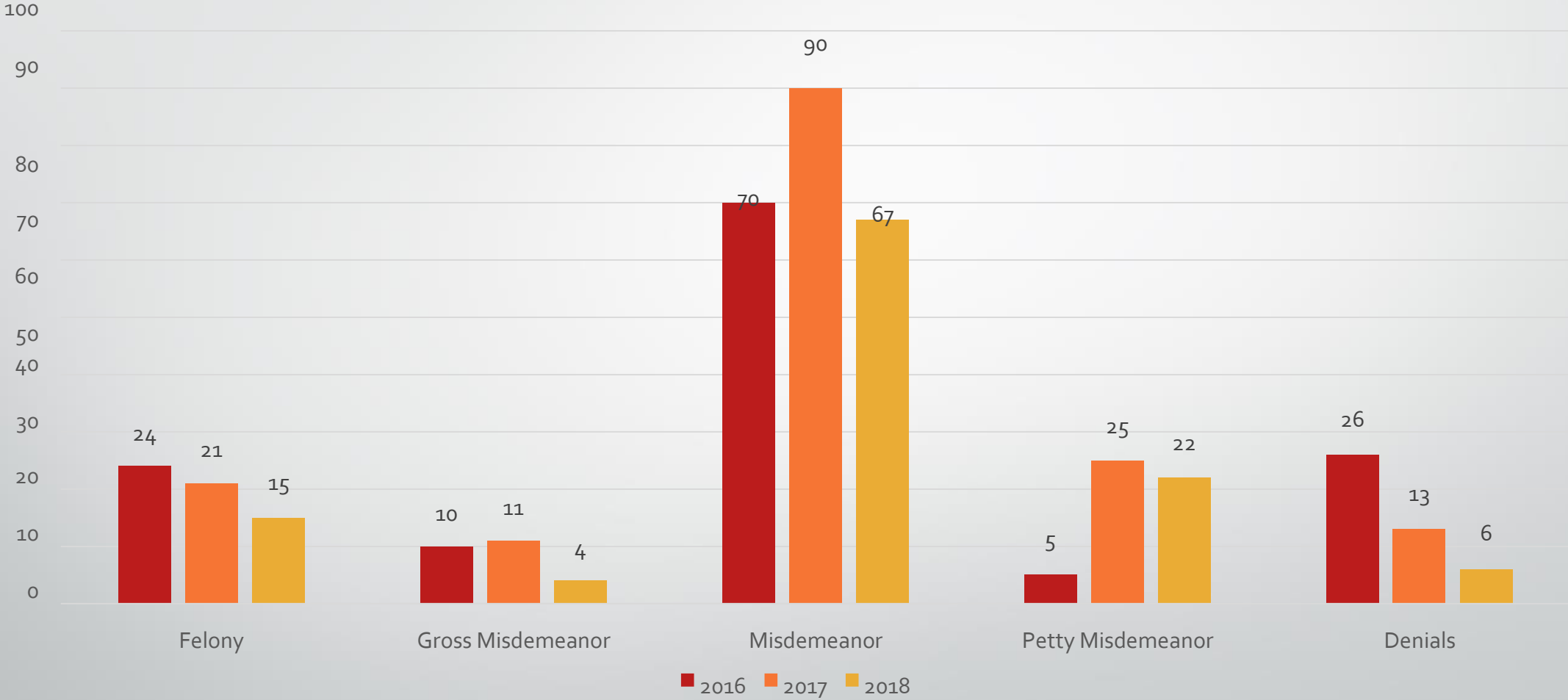

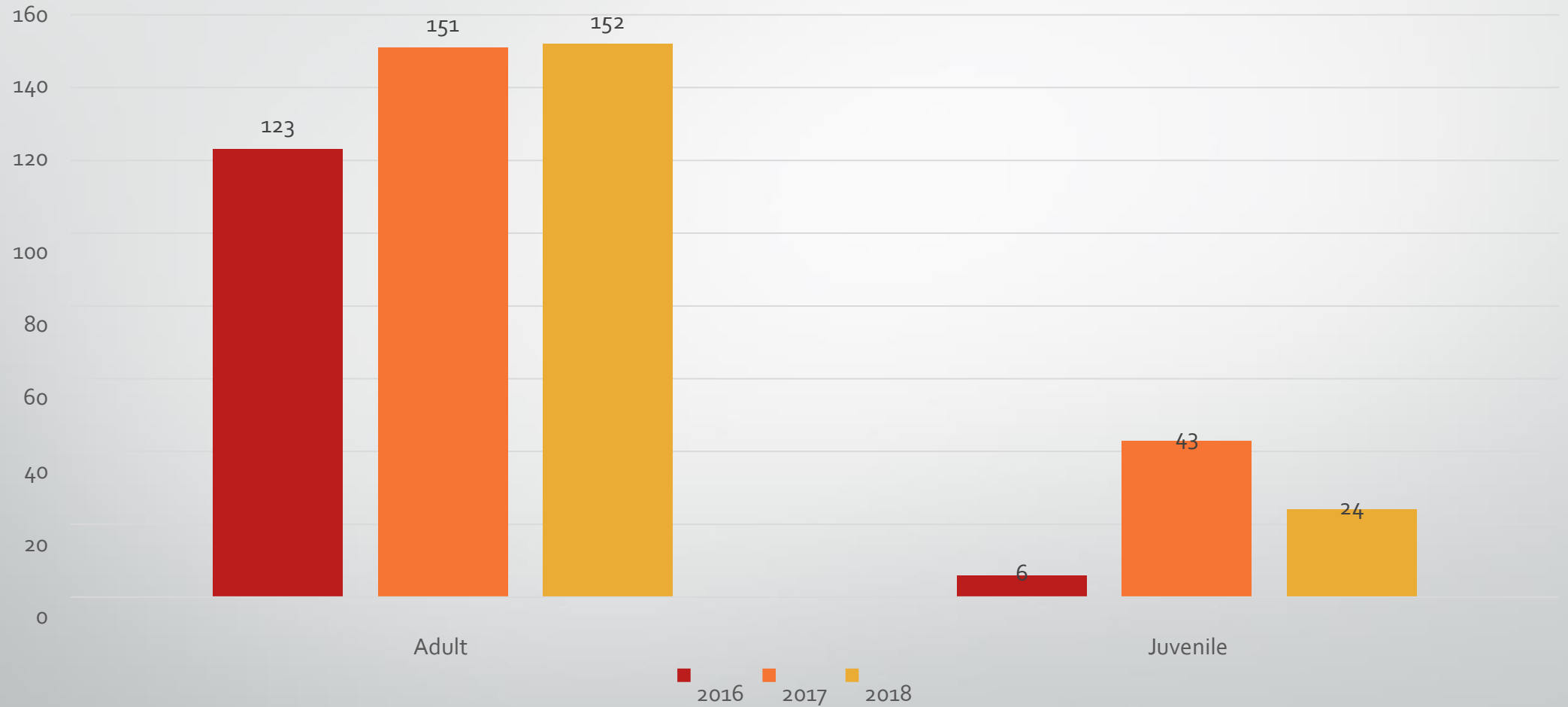

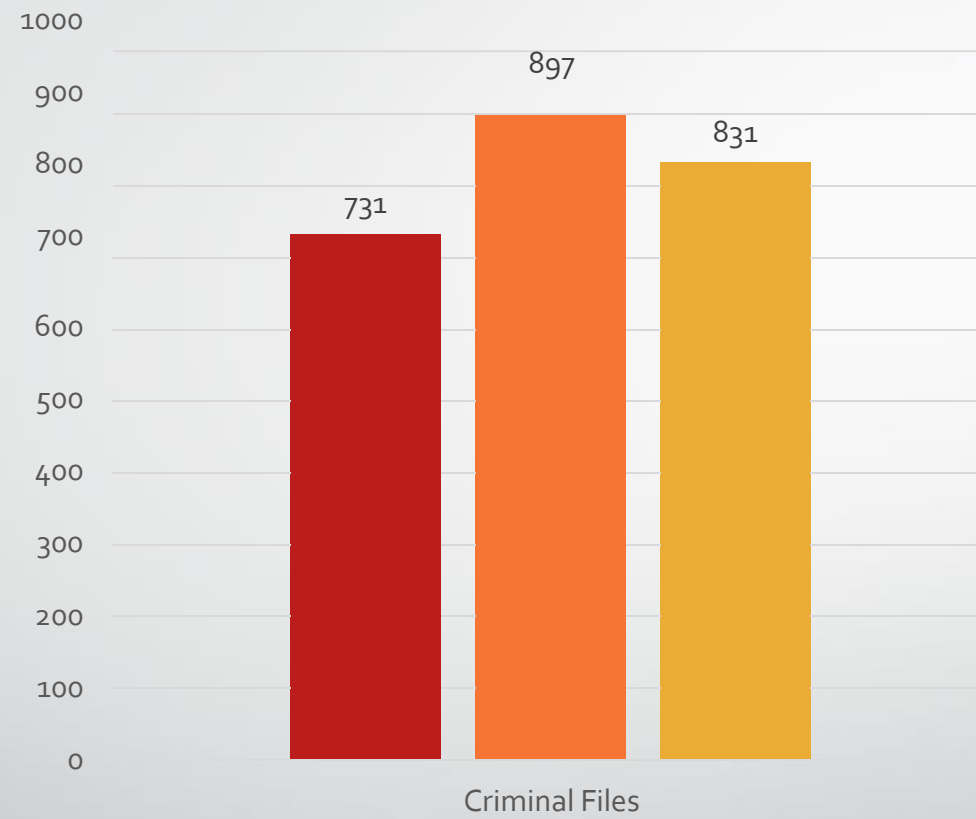
Probation Violations

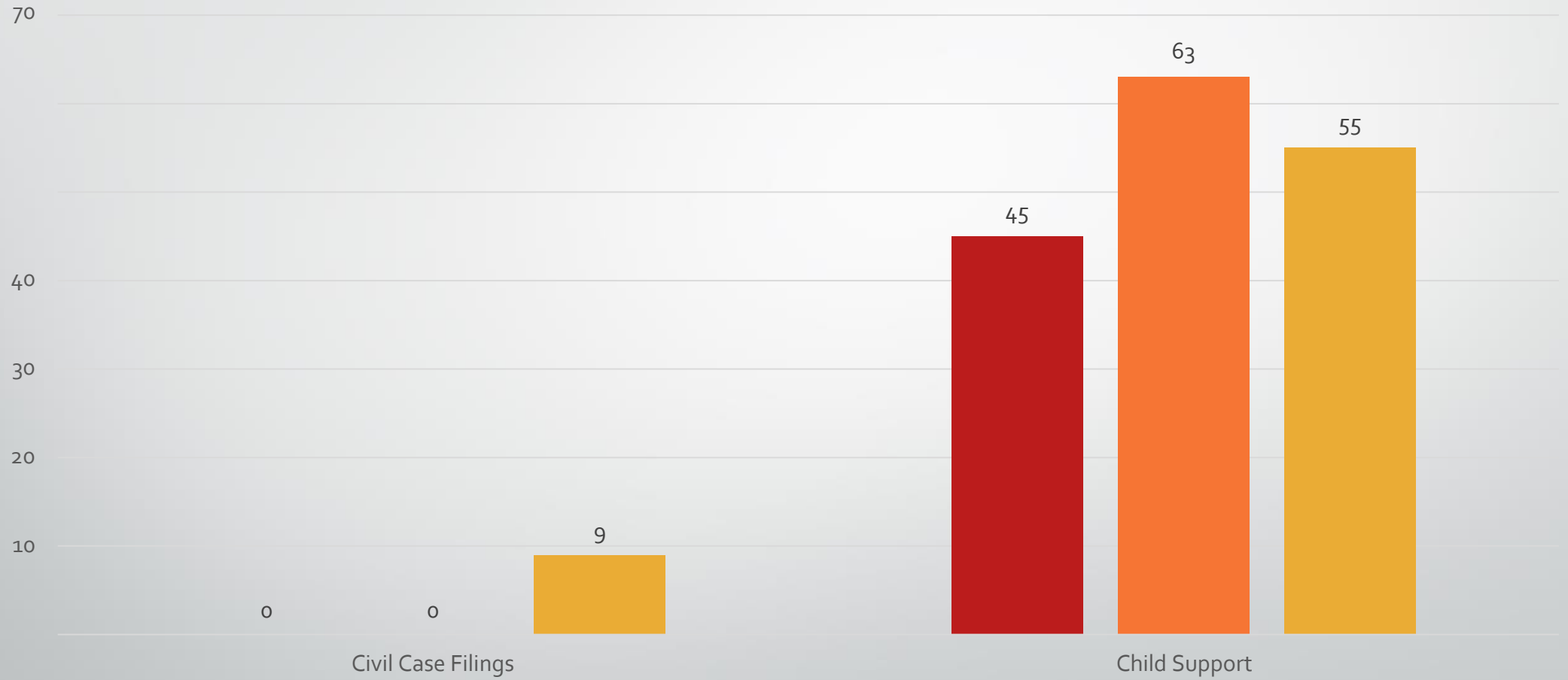

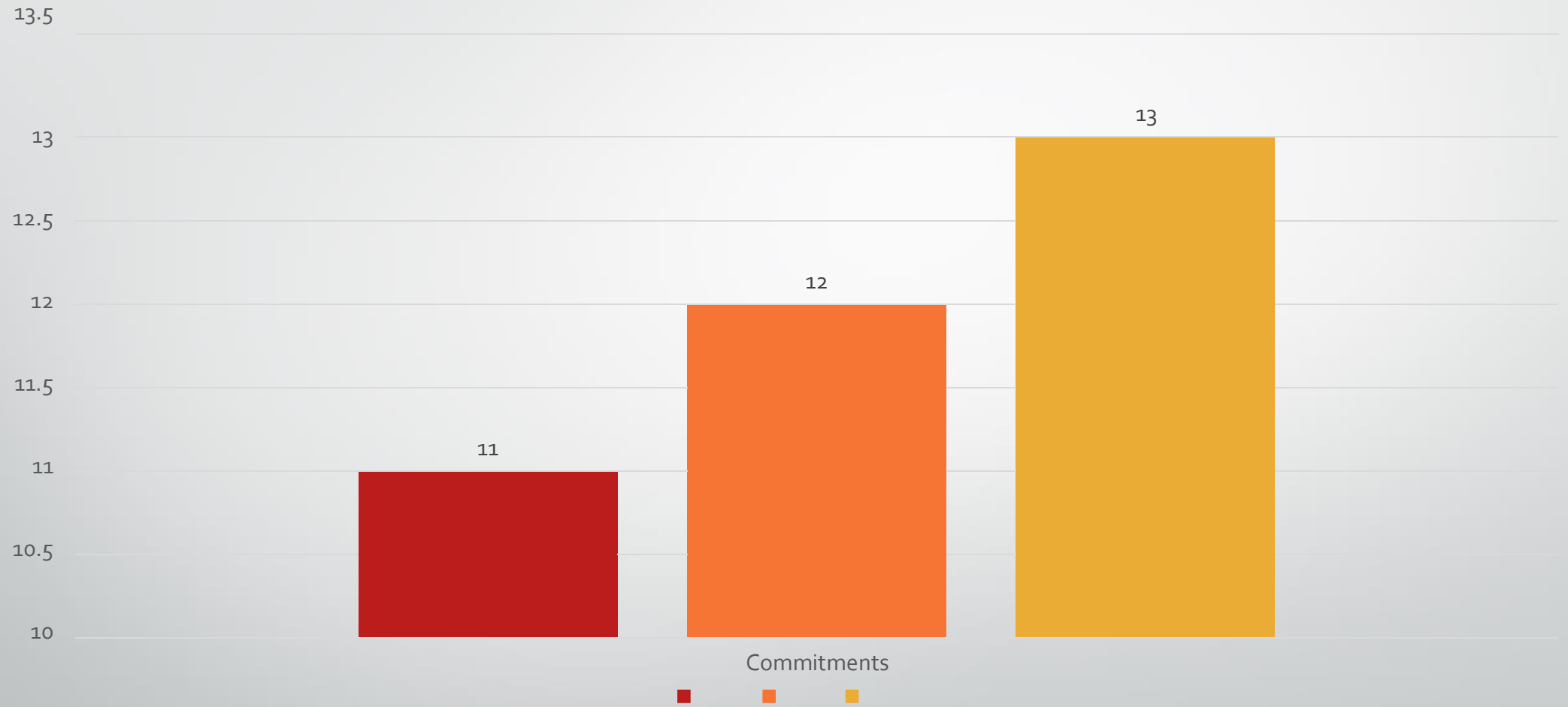
Civil Case Filings

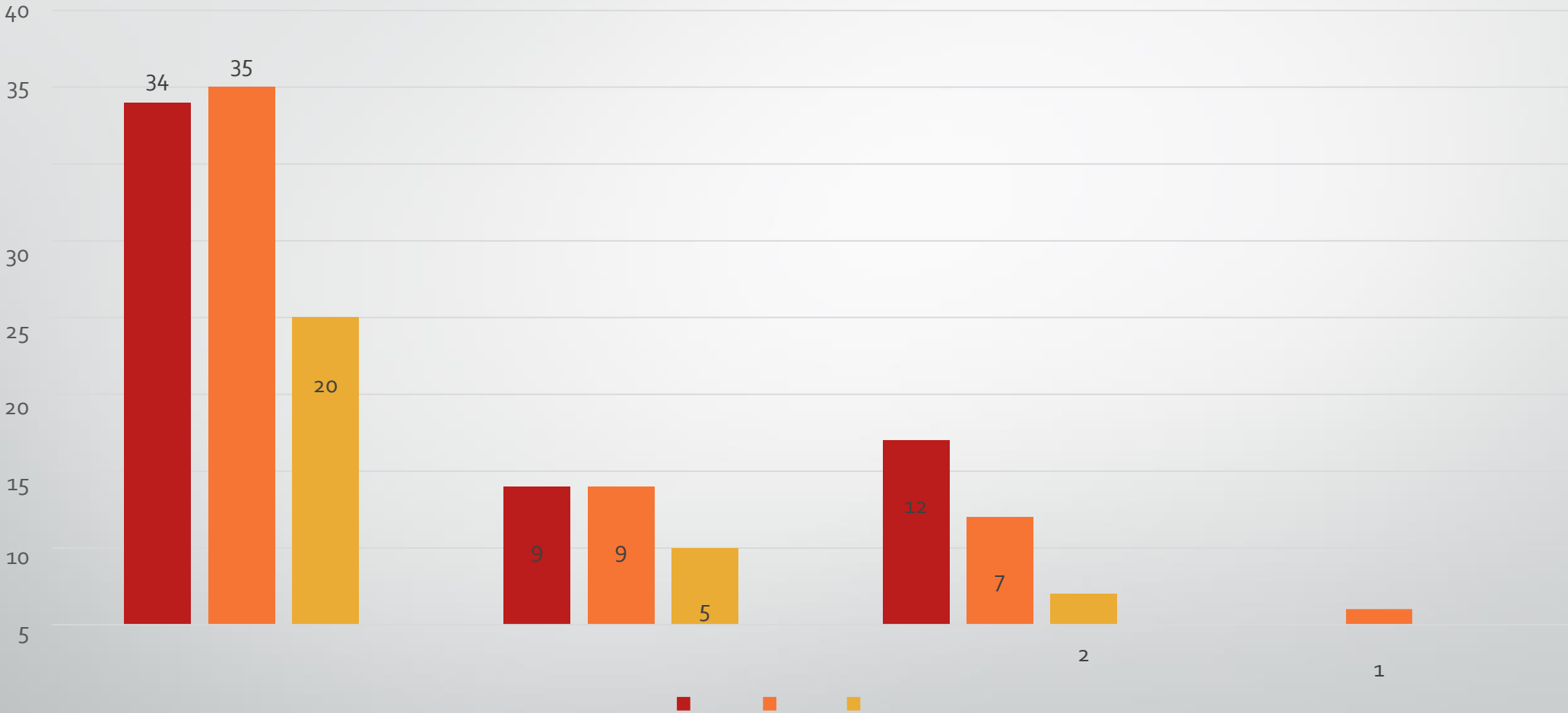

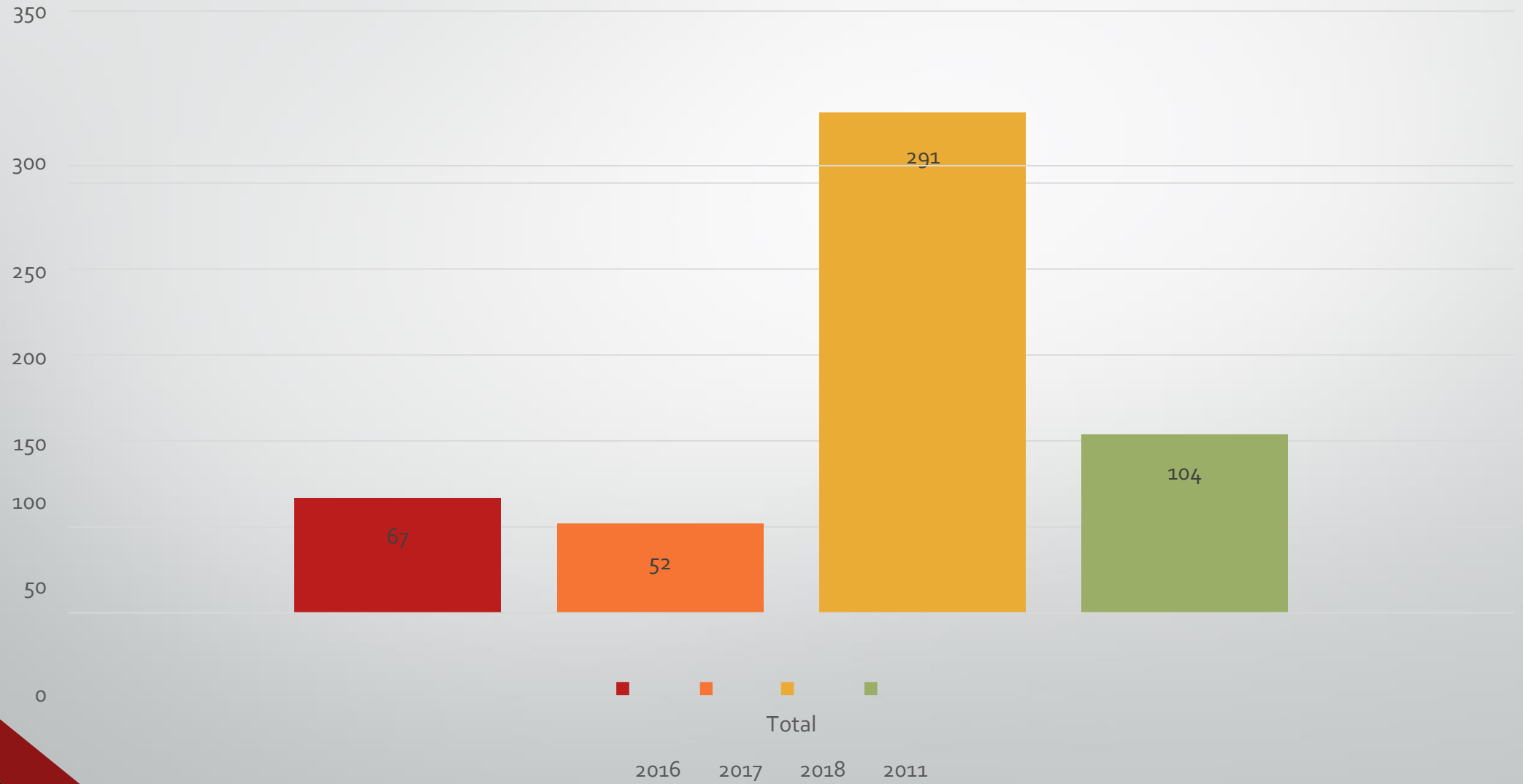

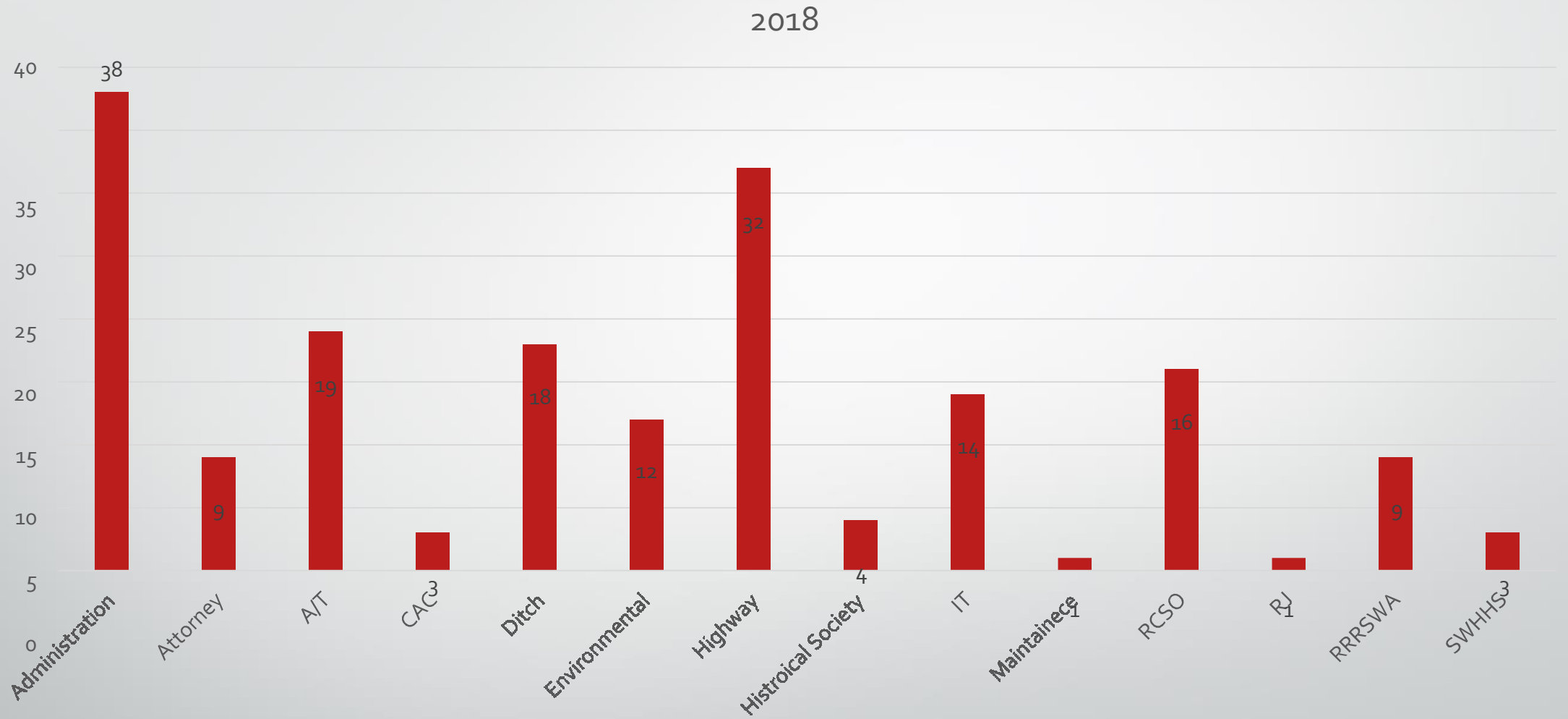

2018 Legal Requests by Department

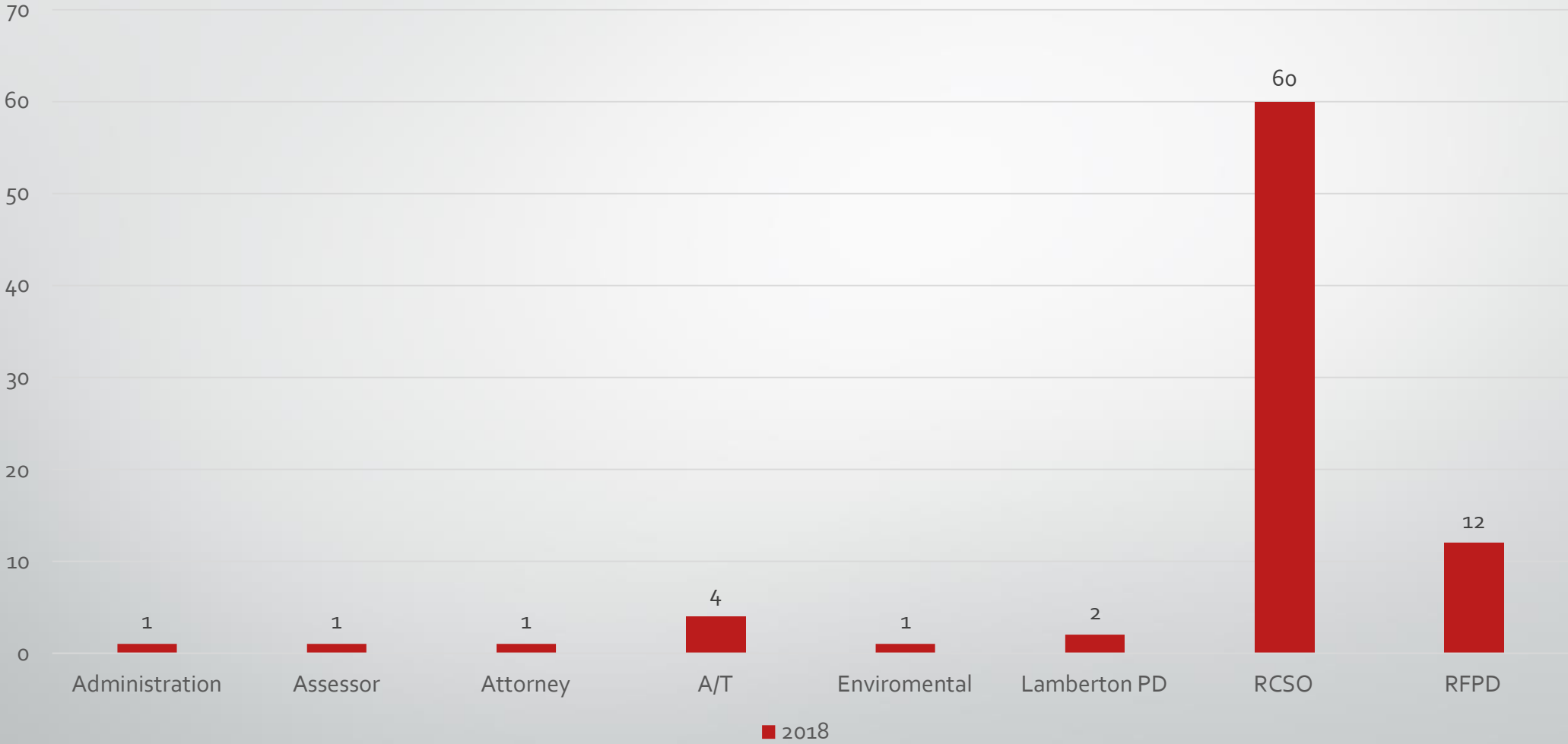

 - Notification of Criminal Justice Events: 831
 - Assistance with Restitution: 64
 - Victim Impact Statement Assistance: 14
 - Provide Information Re: Criminal Justice System: 315
 - Provide Information about Victim Rights: 284
 - Referrals to Victim Services or others: 77
