 - Tuesday, October 29, 2024 (8 a.m. – 7 p.m.)
 - Saturday, November 2, 2024 (9 a.m. – 3 p.m.)
 - Sunday, November 3, 2024 (9 a.m. – 3 p.m.)
 - Monday, November 4, 2024 (8 a.m. – 5 p.m.)

- All absentee ballots must be hand delivered to **the above address** by the voter themselves or an agent for the voter by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day to be counted.
